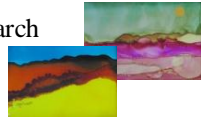

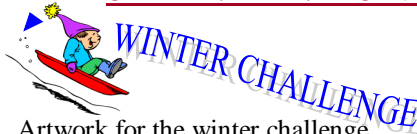

The original drawings will be on one side of the page only because we learned from avid adult colorists that they want to remove their colorful masterpieces from the book and frame them.



Samples of coloring pages will be provided at the Art Guild Brunch on February 21 to help provide ideas for you. Please remember, that even



though there are thousands of free coloring pages online, just waiting to be downloaded and colored, those pages are copyright protected. This protection means that the downloaded pages, created by other artists, can't be sold without the permission of the artist. There are businesses online that will sell the designs, but the cost of these design pages usually begins at \$50.00 per design, depending on the size of the page.

If you wish to participate, you need to do the following:

1. Design your own original 8 x 11 coloring page.
Remember- Zentangles work well!
2. Email as an attachment to bjmidelton@mchsi.com by March 21, 2017 or bring a copy of your work to the Art Guild for the hostess to collect. Please sign your name on the back of the page.

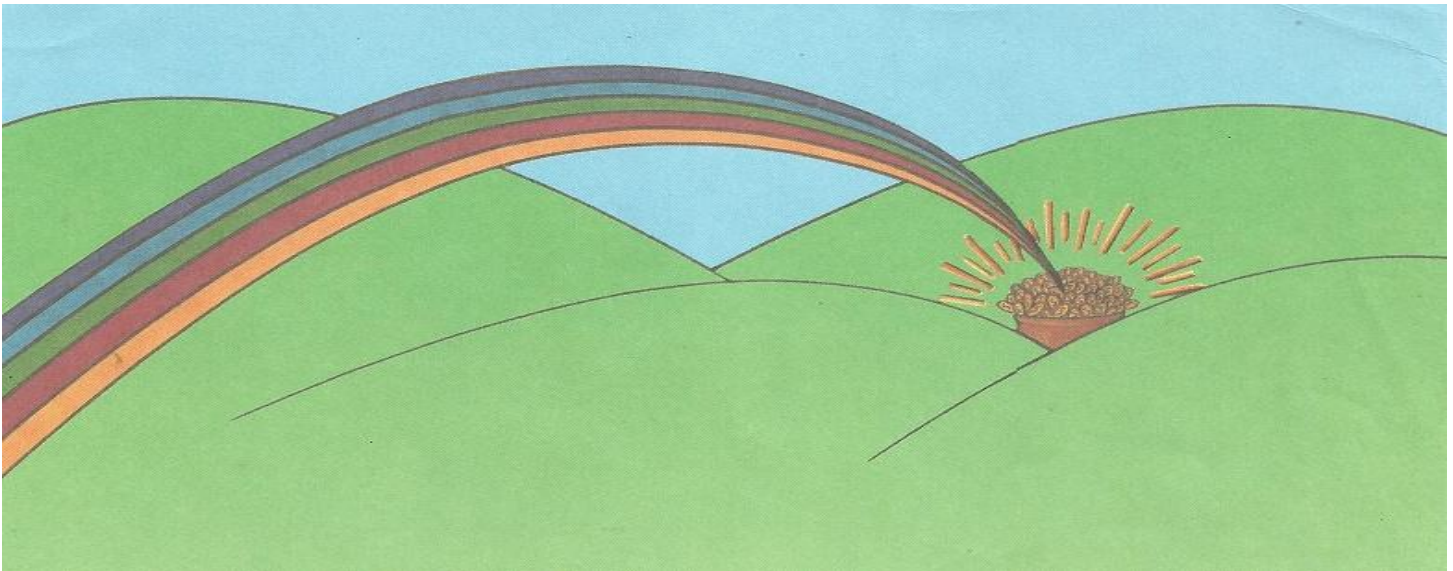
