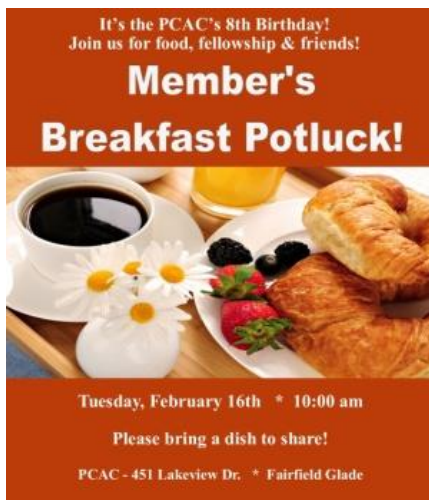

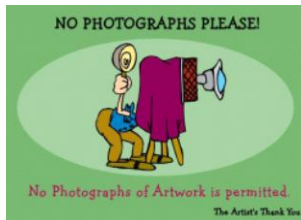

### ▶ **HAPPY BIRTHDAY PCAC!:**

We celebrate the 8<sup>th</sup> birthday of the PCAC building this month! Here is a good time to mention, that in the past 3 years, The Art Guild has paid off over \$30,000 in principal on the mortgage under the 'interest free' anonymous loan. This brings the remaining principal from about \$205,000 in principal to \$177,000 in principal. Congratulations! Art Guild!

### ▶ **ARTISTIC LICENSE PLATES THRU THE TENNESSEE ARTS COMMISSION SUPPORT THE ART GUILD:**

As a not-for-profit organization, the Art Guild relies heavily on support from many sources. Besides our member-volunteers to keep the Art Guild functioning, there are others of support that

help the Art Guild fulfill its goals in the community to "Teach, Learn, Inspire".

One of these sources is the Tennessee Arts Commission. We apply to them for grants to assist us in our day-to-day operations and our outreach programs. The Tennessee Arts Commission has awarded grants to the Art Guild each year. Here's our chance to support them: Tennessee Specialty License Plates:

Part of the Tennessee Arts Commission revenue is generated from the sale of specialty license plates. The sale of specialty license plates account for up to 80% of the funds the TN Arts Commission invests in arts projects and organizations every year through our grant awards. Please consider the purchase of one of these specialty plates the next time you renew your Tennessee License. Here are the current available plates.

All plates in this category:

- are available to all Tennessee residents.
- require an annual fee of \$56.50; \$35 of that fee is allocated in part to the Tennessee Arts Commission
- can be personalized between three and five characters.

## OUTREACH COORDINATORS:

☉ The Community Foundation of Middle Tennessee awarded the Art Guild with a grant to have our artists teach any senior citizens (over 55) in Cumberland County art classes. We are working in conjunction with the Fair Park Senior Center in Crossville. They will provide the room for the classes and will advertise in the newspaper, on their Facebook page and in their newsletter. Our publicity committee will also provide news articles on the grant and the artists.

The seniors can register with the Senior Center and pay a small stipend of \$5.00. All materials needed for the class will be provided by the Art Guild. Our artists will be paid \$10 per student and we will reimburse them for the supplies. If you are interested in teaching, October and November are not filled. So far we have photography, water colors, acrylics, oils and jewelry making.

☉ Friday Fun and Wine Nights are also under Outreach. My special thanks to Nina Hardison and her Hospitality committee for making these Friday nights so enjoyable. This event is a wonderful outreach to show our talent and kindness to others. 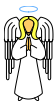
